

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1 Parents of participants will refrain from the use of degrading speech or actions at all official HFL practices or events. This includes yelling at officials, participants, and opposing spectators. Parents will be asked to leave HFL facilities on the first offense.
- 2 Parents are responsible for helping to instill the HFL policy of “KIDS FIRST!! Parents must be upbeat and positive at all times to help their child become motivated to succeed in football and cheerleading.
- 3 Parents are responsible for all equipment issued to their child. Any equipment lost or stolen will be will have its replacement cost charged to the parent. Lost or stolen equipment may result in the player not participating until HFL certified equipment is reissued after payment has been received. Items not specified on the inventory list as being needed for recertification may be kept by the participant.
- 4 Parents are not to alter or repair the equipment on their own. Any alteration of issued equipment will result in a manufacturer’s warranty being voided. Repairs may only be done by a certified HFL representative.
- 5 A uniform practice schedule will be put in place for the convenience of all involved. Coaches are volunteers and do have other work schedules so practices may change. Players must listen to their coach explain to them the schedule of events at the end of practice for the most current information. Handouts are not required to be sent but will try to be passed out if convenient.
- 6 All parents must refrain from sideline coaching at all practices, games, etc. Anyone not certified by the HFL will not be allowed on or near any field during play. This is to protect your child!!!!
- 7 Concerns on any aspects of HFL play, coaching staff, and/or team actions must be brought to the attention of the appropriate franchise commissioner for resolution. Under no circumstances are parents to resolve issues on field with any coach, player, or spectator.
- 8 Parents are responsible to follow the all HFL guidelines of attendance, conduct, and sportsmanship. This is for the safety and development of your child! Parents must have participants at practices and games on time.

The player-parent relationship is important to your child’s growth in the HFL. Parents should not live through their children and their experiences. You are your child’s first role model, please be positive and committed to help your child achieve their goals.

Any violation of the above policy will result in review by the HFL President’s Office and may include dismissal of the parent from HFL facilities at all times.
